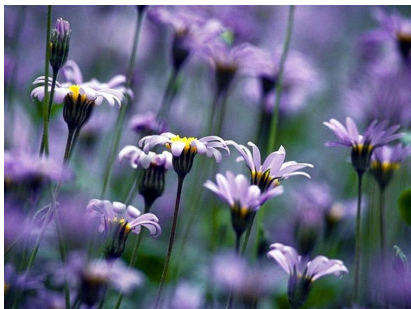


INTERLINK Newsletter – April 2007
